



## Printing & Watermark Support Guide

Thank you for taking a moment to explore ©BLZ resources, whether you are previewing a free sampler or using a full product in your classroom. I appreciate the care you take in selecting high-quality, well-designed materials for your students. To help ensure everything prints smoothly and looks the way it was originally designed, please review the following important notes regarding watermark behavior and printing.

### Watermark Notice:

A faint ©BLZ watermark will appear on screen and on the first printed page when printing directly from the PDF. This safeguard helps protect the integrity of ©BLZ resources and reflects standard best practices within the educational content creation industry. Photocopies made from the original printed master **will not** display the watermark.

### To Make Clean Class Sets:

- 1 Print one original master from the PDF (the watermark will appear).
- 2 Use a copy machine to make one copy of that printed master. The copy should be clean.
- 3 Use the clean copy to make your batch copies for students.

### Printing Tips & Recommendations:

Printers and Copiers tend to have variable settings throughout worksites that need to be taken under consideration. Use the following settings to ensure clean outlines and consistent sizing on school printers and copiers:

- Paper size: US Letter (8.5" × 11")
- Scale: 100% (turn off “Fit to page” or “Shrink to fit”)
- Print quality: High or Best (not Draft)
- Color mode: Black & White or Grayscale
- Duplex printing: Off (unless double-sided printing is preferred)
- First run: Print one test page before batch printing
